## WORLD SHEEP DOG TRIALS 2008 (Llandeilo)

The ISDS will be hosting the next World Sheep Dog Trials at Dinefwr Park, Llandeilo, Carmarthenshire, (South) Wales over 11-14 September 2008. Your sheepdog society is cordially invited to send a team to represent your nation. This letter is being addressed to you as the contact name that we have. If the World Trial administration should be dealt with by another person would you please pass this letter to them for completion **without any delay**.

This is the start of a series of communications over the coming eighteen months that will hopefully lead to handlers from your country competing at the trial. It is therefore **most important** that you complete and return the attached response form by 10 August 2007 so that we can include your information in the planning. If you do not register your details we may assume that your nation is not able to compete.

You will see on the attached form that we have allocated a number of places for dogs from your nation. This allocation has been approved by the Society Council and we tried to be as fair as possible to all countries granting places in proportion to the numbers of competing handlers in each nation. There are 242 places allocated in total, and the event will be organised on very similar lines to those applied for the 2005 World Trials: two days of qualifying over three fields, a semi-finals day and a finals day.

The week before, over 04-06 September, the ISDS will be holding its International Trials at Kimmel Park, Abergele, in North Wales. This means that visitors from far away will have the opportunity to see two major events in less than a two week period. It will be a spectacular and wonderful occasion for us all to be a part of.

Each competing nation will be required to organise a qualification system to select the national team. That qualification must be through fair and open trialling competition during 2007. Obviously, the names of handlers put forward will be those who are able and willing to travel, but they and their qualifying dog must have come somewhere in that national ranking. Any handler may run a maximum of two dogs. Note that the rules will permit each handler to enter a further, alternate dog that does not need to have succeeded at qualification. A full copy of the Rules will be available in August 2007. Each national club will confirm to its entrants who is successful and then submit to the ISDS a completed official entry form for each handler, with the fee, **by 31 March 2008**.
